Rules and Regulations

Club Hours & Schedule

Regular Season Hours: 12:00 PM – 7:30 PM

Saturdays (lessons & baby swim): Starting at 10:30 AM

Lap Lanes: 12:00 PM – 2:00 PM

May: Memorial Day / Opening Day (Saturday or Sunday)

June: Fridays through Sundays

Full Season Begins: Third weekend of June

Section 1: Member and Guest Responsibilities

1. All homeowners and guests require valid identification whenever on Club grounds, as required by the Gatekeeper or Pool Manager.
2. Homeowners and guests are required to sign a copy of these rules each season. Copies are available at www.hhprc.club and at the front gate.
3. Non-members must be accompanied by a homeowner in good standing and must present valid ID at the front gate. Homeowners must remain at the Club for the entire duration of their guests' visit. Guest fees apply once complimentary passes have been exhausted.
4. Private instructors must sign in at the front gate. They are considered guests and are subject to all guest rules, including applicable guest fees.
5. Homeowners who are not in good standing with the Club are not eligible to attend as a guest of another member.
6. No child under the age of 12 may enter the Club without direct parental supervision.
7. Homeowners are responsible for informing their guests of all risks involved in using the Club's facilities. By signing in a guest, homeowners automatically indemnify and hold the Association harmless against any claims arising from the guest's use of the facilities.

Section 2: Conduct & Safety

8. **No alcoholic beverages of any kind** may be consumed on Club premises. If consumption is suspected, the Pool Manager, a Board member, or Lead Supervisor has the right to inspect and confiscate containers. Any member found in possession of alcohol will be removed and may lose Club privileges, as determined by the Board of Trustees.
9. Smoking and vaping are strictly prohibited on all Club grounds.
10. Glass and breakable containers are not permitted anywhere on Club grounds.
11. Running, horseplay, and loud personal music are prohibited. Chewing gum is not permitted in or around the pool area.
12. Bicycles, roller-blades, skateboards, and all similar mobility devices may not be used inside the Club or on the courts.
13. Pets of any kind are not permitted on Club grounds.
14. Homeowners and guests may not verbally or physically abuse, reprimand, or discipline any Club employee. Complaints or concerns must be submitted in writing to the Board of Directors or via the email form on the Club website.

Section 3: Pool Rules

Main Pool

15. The lifeguards and/or Pool Manager have sole discretion to administer a swim test to any member or guest. Refusal of a swim test by a child or parent is grounds for prohibiting the child from the main pool until the lifeguards or Pool Manager are satisfied with the child's swimming ability.
16. The Pool Manager and/or lifeguards will determine where a child may swim based on demonstrated ability.
17. **No flotation devices of any kind (wings, tubes, vests, etc.)** may be worn while using the diving boards or in the diving area. Flotation devices are not a substitute for swimming competence and may not be used in the main pool past 3 feet.
18. Adult-sized flotation rafts are prohibited in the main pool during peak hours.
19. Suffolk County Health Department regulations require that any person who causes pool contamination will be held

financially responsible for the cost of draining, refilling, and retreating the pool. Commercial swim diapers are required for all children under the age of 3 or not potty trained.

Diving Area

20. Only forward dives are permitted from the diving board. No swimmer may remain in the diving area while the board is in use. Only one (1) person is permitted on the board at a time.

Section 4: Picnic Area & Food Policy

21. Outside food orders are not permitted while the concession stand is open. Food may only be consumed in the picnic area.
22. All members and guests must dispose of garbage in the trash containers located near the concession stand. Eating anywhere outside the picnic area is prohibited.

Section 5: Tennis, Pickleball & Basketball Court Rules

The tennis, pickleball, and basketball courts are newly installed amenities provided for the enjoyment of all members. They are not supervised by Club staff. Use of these courts is entirely at your own risk. All members and guests are expected to treat these facilities with care and respect so that they remain in excellent condition for years to come.

23. Court use is unsupervised. All players use the courts at their own risk. The Club assumes no liability for injuries sustained on the courts.
24. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times while using the courts.
25. There is a one (1.5) hour time limit per court. Courts must be vacated at the top of each hour if others are waiting.
26. No food, drinks, or garbage may be left on the courts. Players are responsible for removing all personal items and disposing of trash properly before leaving.
27. Dragging, sliding, or moving nets, benches, or court equipment is strictly prohibited. Equipment must be left in its designated position at all times.
28. These courts are a new Club amenity and must be treated as such. Vandalism, misuse, or willful damage to court surfaces or equipment will result in suspension of court privileges and may be subject to further disciplinary action by the Board of Trustees.

Section 6: Emergency & Safety Procedures

29. In the event of a pool emergency, all swimmers must exit the pool immediately upon a lifeguard's signal or whistle. Members and guests must follow all directions given by lifeguards and the Pool Manager without delay.
30. The Club is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property on Club grounds. Members and guests bring valuables at their own risk.
31. First aid is available at the lifeguard station. In the event of a serious injury or medical emergency, call 911 immediately.
32. In the event of lightning or severe weather, all swimmers must exit the pool and pool area immediately upon the lifeguard's signal. Re-entry will be permitted only when the lifeguard or Pool Manager determines it is safe to do so.

Any violation of these rules by a homeowner or guest may subject the homeowner to suspension for a term determined by the Board of Trustees.

Unless otherwise noted, the Lifeguards, Pool Manager, and Board of Trustees have final authority over the interpretation and enforcement of all rules. This document does not represent a complete list of all Club rules and responsibilities.
